Prague public transport

Dear colleagues,

As you will need to move around the city during the Staff Training Week, I would like to share some information about Prague public transport and tips for a better orientation.

The public transport in Prague works well – you can use the subway, trams, buses or trolleybuses. The general information and transport net maps can be found on this website:

How do you find a connection? Just go on the website of Prague Integrated Transport, "PID", and search for the connection you need: <https://pid.cz/en/>. I recommend you also download their mobile application, where you can search for all connections and departures as well as manage ticket purchases. You can find more information on the website: <https://app.pidlitacka.cz/o-aplikaci>. The app is available on Google Play and the Apple Store. Unfortunately, the app doesn't have a high rating, but I use it almost daily and am satisfied. So, you will see. ;)
